The Isle of Ré, long a land of sailors and salt producers, combines a rich history with unspoilt nature. Between Vauban fortifications, typical villages and salt marshes, it offers a peaceful setting for cycling to the rhythm of the ocean.

Access: 30 min from La Rochelle (toll bridge) / Ideal by bike / Shuttle bus

☀ Morning: Visit Saint-Martin-de-Ré, its Vauban ramparts and charming port. Enjoy an ice cream at La Martinière (try the oyster or caramel ones!). Cycle through the marshes to La Flotte or Ars-en-Ré.

☀ Noon: Relax on the Gros Joncs beach (Bois-Plage-en-Ré), perfect for families. Have lunch in a crêperie or picnic on the sand.

☀ Afternoon: Climb the 257 steps to the Phare des Baleines for an exceptional view. Enjoy the museum, dunes, stores and a well-deserved snack.

☀ Bonus: craft market, pineau tasting, island salt and Retais shortbread. Magical sunset at La Couarde or Saint-Clément.

☀ Tips: Sunscreen, water, bike lock, restaurant reservations recommended in high season.

Isle of Aix / Fort Boyard

Just a stone's throw from La Rochelle, isle of Aix offers a timeless getaway. A small pearl accessible only by boat, it can be discovered on foot or by bike, between quiet beaches, wild creeks and flower-filled lanes. The atmosphere is peaceful, almost island-like in the purest sense of the word. Along the way, don't miss the not-to-be-missed cruise around the mythical Fort Boyard, a veritable icon of the region. A sea excursion that will delight young and old alike, with an exceptional panorama of the Charente coastline. A change of scenery guaranteed, just a stone's throw from the course!

Don't miss an oyster tasting in a typical oyster hut, and take advantage of the bike paths to explore the island in comfort!

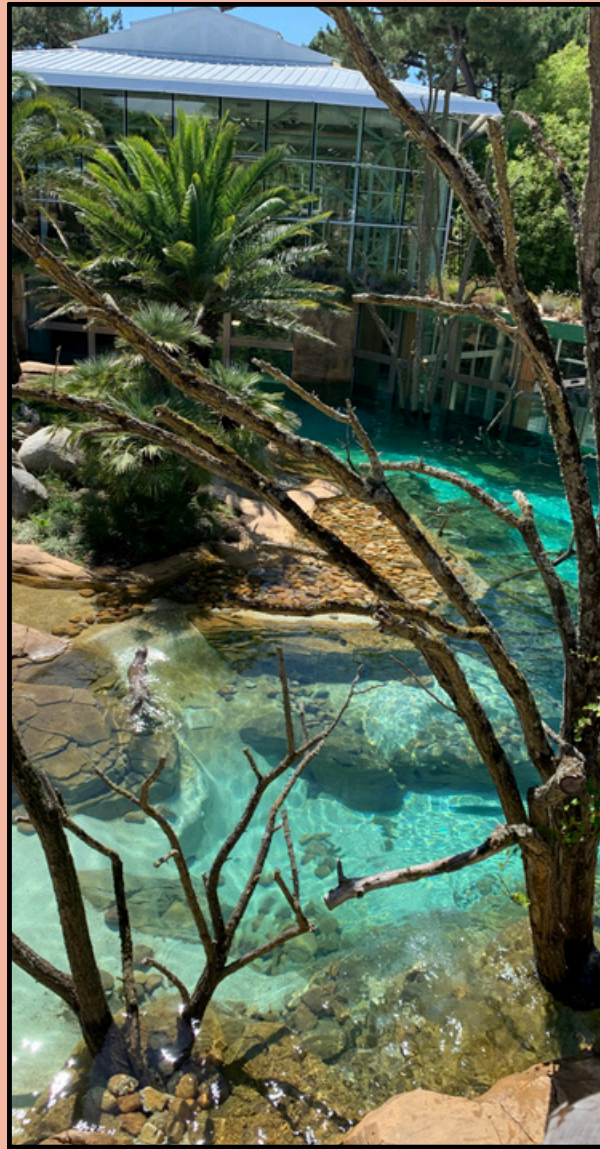
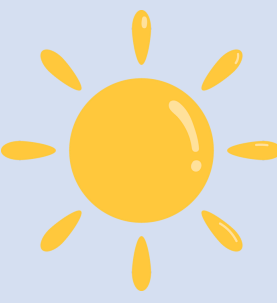


Bonus: L'Écume in Saint-Trojan-les-Bains

La Palmyre / Royan



Royan – Seaside & sweet treats

A family-friendly seaside resort in the 50's style, Royan seduces visitors with its central beach, lively seafront and... its famous home-made sweet treats from confectioner Lopez, an institution for gourmets.

Zoo de La Palmyre

One of Europe's largest zoos, housing over 1,600 animals in a verdant setting. A fun and educational visit, ideal for the whole family, just 1 hour from La Rochelle.

Beaches – Grande Côte & Phare de La Coubre

Between fine sand and pine forests, the beaches of the Grande Côte are perfect for lazing around or surfing. Further north, climb up to the La Coubre lighthouse for a spectacular view of the Gironde estuary.

Luna Park – Sensations & fun in Les Mathes

An open-air amusement park open all summer long, Luna Park offers rides, games and a festive atmosphere at dusk. Fun for young and old, just a few minutes from the zoo!

Founded in the Middle Ages, it was a major trading port and an influential Protestant city, whose famous medieval towers still guard the entrance. Today, with its narrow arcaded streets, old sailing ships, lively markets and maritime atmosphere, La Rochelle is the ideal place to combine relaxation, culture and discovery. La Rochelle – visits

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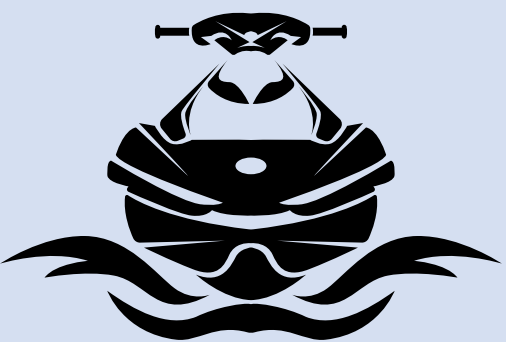
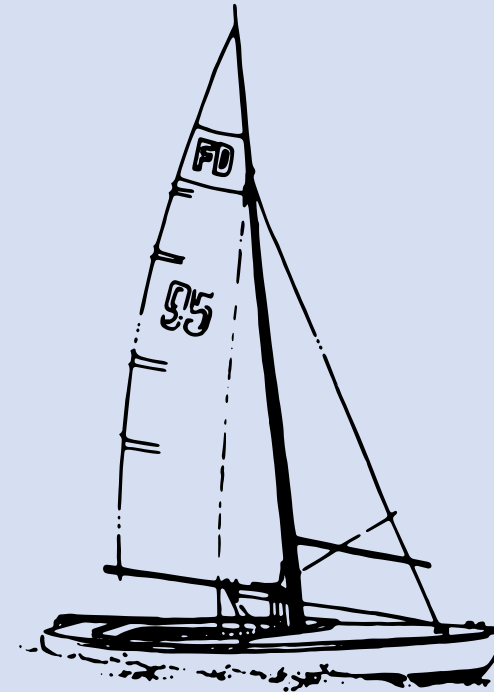
- **The Three Towers:** Saint-Nicolas, Chaîne and Lanterne – emblematic medieval remains that have watched over the harbor entrance for centuries. A panoramic climb not to be missed!
- **Stroll through the Old Port:** lively atmosphere, cafés, street artists and superb sunsets. Stroll through the charming arcades of the city center.
- **Musée Maritime:** Come aboard real boats to discover the city's naval history. An ideal interactive visit for young and old alike.
- **La Rochelle's parks:** Parc Charruyer with its free-roaming animals, or Parc Franck-Delmas for a picnic in the shade of the maritime pines.



La Rochelle – water activities

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La Rochelle is an ideal destination for sea lovers! Treat yourself to a sunset **catamaran** cruise (approx. 2 hours – €35/person) for a magical moment overlooking the ocean. The more adventurous can opt for a **jet-ski ride** around the Île de Ré – thrills guaranteed! Do you have a boating license? It's also possible **to rent a boat** for the day and freely explore the maritime surroundings. As a family, don't miss **the Aquarium de La Rochelle** (from €18.50), one of the finest in Europe, with its 12,000 marine animals. Finally, for a relaxing break, head for the beaches: **Les Minimes**, with its long promenade and view of the Phare du Bout du Monde lighthouse, or **the Plage de la Concurrence**, more central and pleasant at high tide.



Fine dining in the old port

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Iséo – Franco–Thai fusion with character

Located on the banks of the Old Port, Iséo seduces gourmets with a fusion of French tradition and Asian flavors. Spicy flavors, meticulous preparation and a friendly atmosphere make this restaurant a must in La Rochelle, for both lunch and dinner.

Les Flots – Marine gastronomy with a historic view

Nestled at the foot of the Tour de la Chaîne, this emblematic restaurant offers a breathtaking view of the Old Port. The cuisine, focused on seafood, combines quality, creativity and refinement. Since 1997, Grégory Coutanceau has been bringing his gastronomic vision to this place steeped in history.

Galanga – Thai spirit in a chic setting

A stone's throw from the central market, Galanga modernizes Thai cuisine in a refined, intimate setting. The founders reinvent classics with freshness and elegance, offering an authentic Asian culinary experience far from the hustle and bustle of big cities.

Carlotta – Italian-style pizza, with passion

At Carlotta, pizza is an art: homemade dough matured for 48 hours, ingredients imported from Italy, and original recipes blending truffle, Gorgonzola or Nduja. The atmosphere is generous and festive, as are the signature cocktails with Mediterranean accents. A true corner of Italy in the heart of La Rochelle!



And for the curious and the gourmet, rue de la Chaîne and rue St-Jean-du-Pérot also abound in a variety of restaurants: world specialties, convivial brasseries or more intimate addresses... something to delight every taste bud in La Rochelle!

La Rochelle by night ! –

A La Rochelle institution since 1933, this typical bar on rue Saint-Nicolas offers a light, fruity house drink in a popular, friendly atmosphere. Charcuterie boards to share on the premises.

Mac Ewan's Pub

Located on rue de la Chaîne, this Irish-inspired pub mixes draught beers, whiskies and cocktails in a warm rock atmosphere. Perfect for a relaxed evening to the sound of a good playlist.

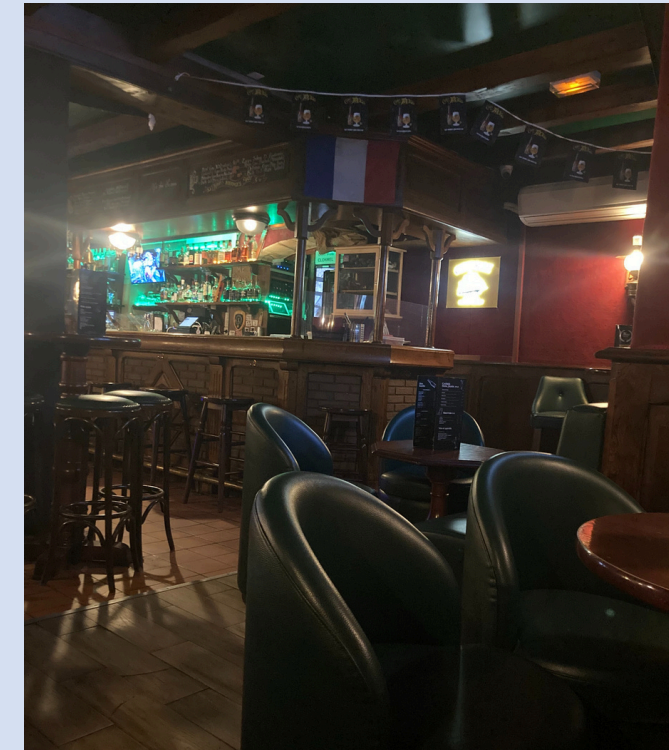
